

WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO BRING TO AGILITY CLASS :

- **Please mail a copy of dog's shot records with your check if you can. Otherwise bring this info to the first class. Titters are also acceptable. If you give your own shots, a copy of the type of vaccine is fine. Have questions, call me.**
- A buckle collar or a quick release collar. **Choke collars are not allowed unless prior approval from instructor.**
- A 6 foot leash - **not a flex leash.**
- **LOTS** of the dog's favorite food treats. **Prefer a treat that you do not use at home - something different.** Place them in a pouch so you can keep several in your pocket at all times.
- **A HUNGRY DOG ! Don't feed your dog prior to class. If you feel you must feed your dog, plan to feed at least 4 hours prior to class, OR feed when you get home. This makes the dog's attention that much keener !**
- **Be ready for you and your dog to have fun !** Wear comfortable shoes (either tennis shoes or closed toe shoes, no sandals please) and comfortable clothing. You will be working on rubber mats. Building temperature is around 60 degrees but you will be moving around with your dog.

OTHER NOTES:

Clean up after your dog. Please take a moment before leaving home to exercise your dog. However, accidents sometimes happen. There will be the appropriate tools necessary for you to clean up if your dog has an accident. Please walk your dog in designated areas only.

Not allowed:

- **Aggressive dogs.** Dogs should not exhibit aggressiveness either towards other dogs or towards people.
- **Harsh training methods.** No pinch collars.
- **If your dog comes into the breeding cycle, please keep your dog home for the entire breeding cycle.** You are welcome to come and watch the class & get the handouts. Sometimes you can learn just as much by watching as participating.
